### 2019 STATE RALLY CHAMPION

**Judges: Mrs Kim Houlden & Mr Edwin Howden**

All qualifying class winners are invited to compete for this award. Participation is not compulsory. Entry will be restricted to one round per dog and handler team. Judging will take place over a modified novice course. The highest qualifying score will be the winner, should scores be level, the award will go to the fastest time, should the times be equal, the winner will be determined at the discretion of the judges

All presentations for the day will take place after the rally champion run-off
